

## Defense and Graduation Deadlines for Anschutz Medical Campus Thesis MS and PhD Students Academic Year 2026-2027

[Watch](#) how to prepare the correct forms and upload your dissertation.

**Note: Missing deadlines delays degree conferral to the next term.** These are published a year in advance to support planning and ensure all graduation requirements are met. Deadlines differ for non-thesis MS students (see Graduation Deadlines for Non-Thesis MS Students).

PhD students who defend before the semester ends do not need to register again—just apply to graduate next term (e.g., defend on Nov 21, 2025 → apply for Spring 2026). International students should check with ISSS about graduation timing.

### Reminders to Master's candidates:

- Refer to your unofficial transcript as you type your Application for Candidacy. Do not include failed classes or classes that will not be applied to your degree. Courses listed on the Application for Candidacy cannot be counted toward a future master's degree.
- All transfer credits must be posted before you submit your Application for Candidacy.
