Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This conference will explore the diverse sources which shape perspectives about ethical issues in pediatric care. Subjective, objective, identity, role, and normative aspects must be distinguished and considered in ethical analysis. Ethics faculty, parents, providers and other health care professionals will guide inquiry through personal and professional experience, as well as case discussion. Participants will report an increased understanding of "humble expertise," and how this organizational value can positively inform ethical reflection and guide patient care.
