forcibly sterilized during the 1970s in an American hospital.

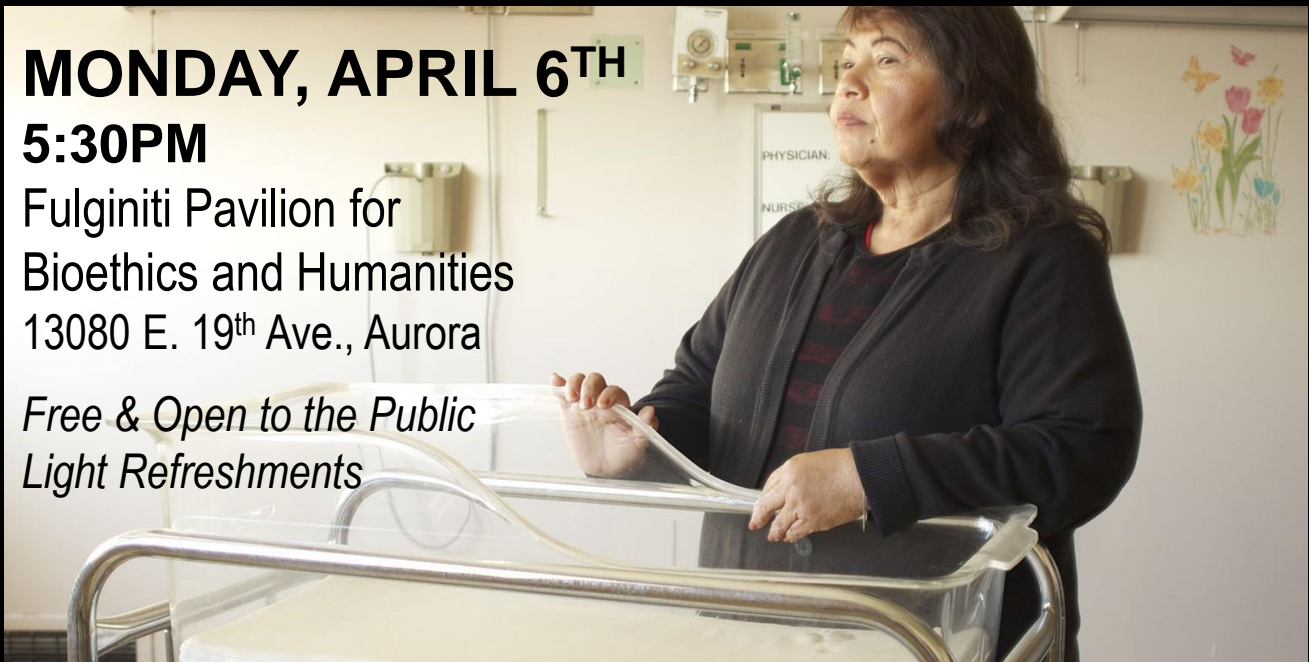
