

## How to Search for Courses that Offer Low Cost, No Cost, and/or Open Educational Resources

CU Anschutz knows that open educational resources (OER) can provide a measurable impact on student success. OER textbooks, or “open textbooks”, mean that an author has chosen to give others permission to retain, reuse, revise, remix, and redistribute copies of their content. There are certain classes available to CU Anschutz students that provide the following options:

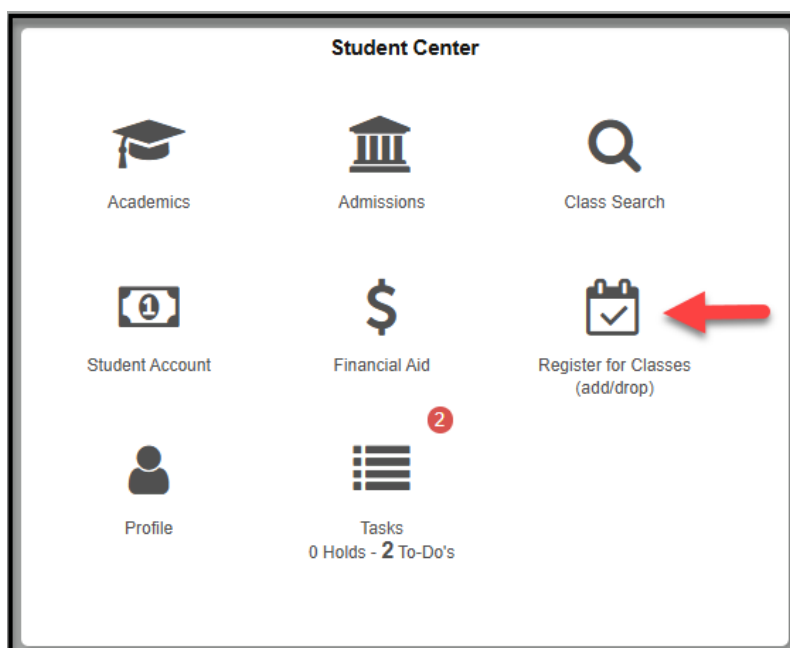
- No Cost Textbooks and/or Course Materials
- Low-Cost Textbooks and/or Course Materials for less than \$20
- Open Educational Resources

Below is a guide on how to search for these courses in the Student Portal.

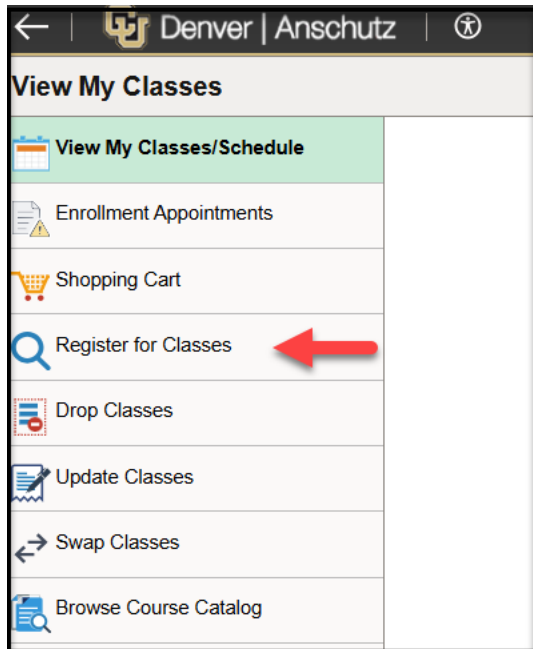

Process:

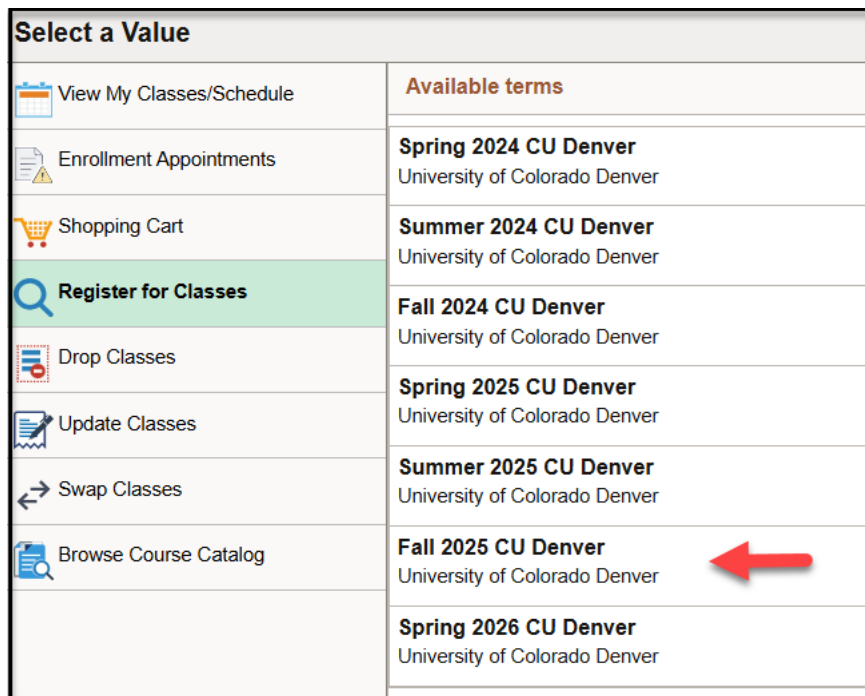
1. [Log into the UCDAccess Student Portal](#). In the Student Center, click **Register for Classes (add/drop)**.



2. On the navigation menu on the left-hand side of the screen, click **Register for Classes**.








3. Select the **term** for registration.
