



Fig. 2: 'Understanding CKD' Survey Results





Results

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- Participants reported:
 - Already comfortable discussing their care with their provider
 - Not difficult to find or understand **CKD** information
- However:
 - Low levels of confidence and understanding for most CKD topics
- "Understanding CKD's" impact:
 - Improved confidence and understanding in **almost every** concept measured

Broader Impact

- Improve health literacy on a **massive** scale for next to no cost
 - Reach patients who lack access to healthcare
- Increased health literacy directly results in improved disease outcome
- Alleviate CKD patient and cost burden on healthcare services
- Educational format can be used for other diseases to promote a healthier community (diabetes, heart disease, etc.)
