Screen Readers

- Windows: The Windows version of LockDown Browser is tested through the vendor and works with most available screen readers. Respondus recommends using the screen reader NVDA on Windows. There is a known issue with KutzweilReadTheWeb reading answer responses in LockDownBrowser.
- Mac: The Mac and iPad versions of LockDown Browser are tested through the vendor and work with VoiceOver. VoiceOver is built into the Mac OS. More about VoiceOver
- Chrome OS (Chromebooks): The LockDown Browser for Chromebook Extension is tested through the vendor and works with ChromeVox. ChromeVox is built into the Chrome OS and can be triggered by using the following key combination: Ctrl+Alt+Z

LockDown Browser's functions and security remain the same when these screen readers are used. LockDown Browser does not block screen readers and conforms to WCAG 2.1.
